

NEW GEOGRAPHY COURSES IN 2009-2010

What Does It Mean For You?

The New Courses

In the Fall Term of 2009, the Department of Geography is introducing a group of four new lower-level courses to replace a group of four current courses. Although each new course is not a direct substitute for any single old course, for the purposes of program requirements and listing of prerequisites for higher level courses, the following substitutions will be made:

Old Course	Corresponding New Course
GEOG 1203.1(.2) Phys. Geog.: Global Patterns	GEOG 1200.1(.2) People, Place, and Environment
GEOG 1204.1(.2) Demographics and Culture	GEOG 1100.1(.2) Global Perspect. on Land and Life
GEOG 2213.1(.2) Phys. Geog.: Local & Reg. Patt.	GEOG 2100.1(.2) Fundamentals of Physical Geography
GEOG 2214.1(.2) Environment and Livelihood	GEOG 2200.1(.2) Fundamentals of Human Geography

- If you completed one of the old courses with a grade of C or higher, you will be considered to have met the prerequisite for any course that lists the corresponding new course, shown above, as its prerequisite.
- If you completed one of the old courses, you will not be permitted to register in the corresponding new course.
- If you have not completed one or more of the old courses, you may register in the corresponding new course or courses.

What It Means for Your Program

For *B.A. Major, Honours, Minor, and Concentration*, the current requirements include:

- A. GEOG 1203.1(.2), 1204.1(.2), and either 2213.1(.2) or 2214.1(.2)

The new program requirements will be:

- B. GEOG 1100.1(.2), 1200.1(.2), and either 2100.1(.2) or 2200.1(.2)

If you took one or more of the old courses, you will not have to take the corresponding new course(s) to fulfill these requirements. However, if you have only partially completed the requirements in line A., then you will need to take the necessary corresponding new course or courses, as shown above, to complete the requirements in line B.

For *B.Sc. Major, Honours, Minor, and Concentration*, the current requirements include:

- C. GEOG 1203.1(.2), 1204.1(.2), and 2213.1(.2)

The new program requirements will be:

- D. GEOG 1100.1(.2), 1200.1(.2), and 2100.1(.2)

If you took one or more of the old courses, you will not have to take the corresponding new course(s) to fulfill these requirements. However, if you have only partially completed the requirements in line C., then you will need to take the necessary corresponding new course or courses, as shown above, to complete the requirements in line D.
