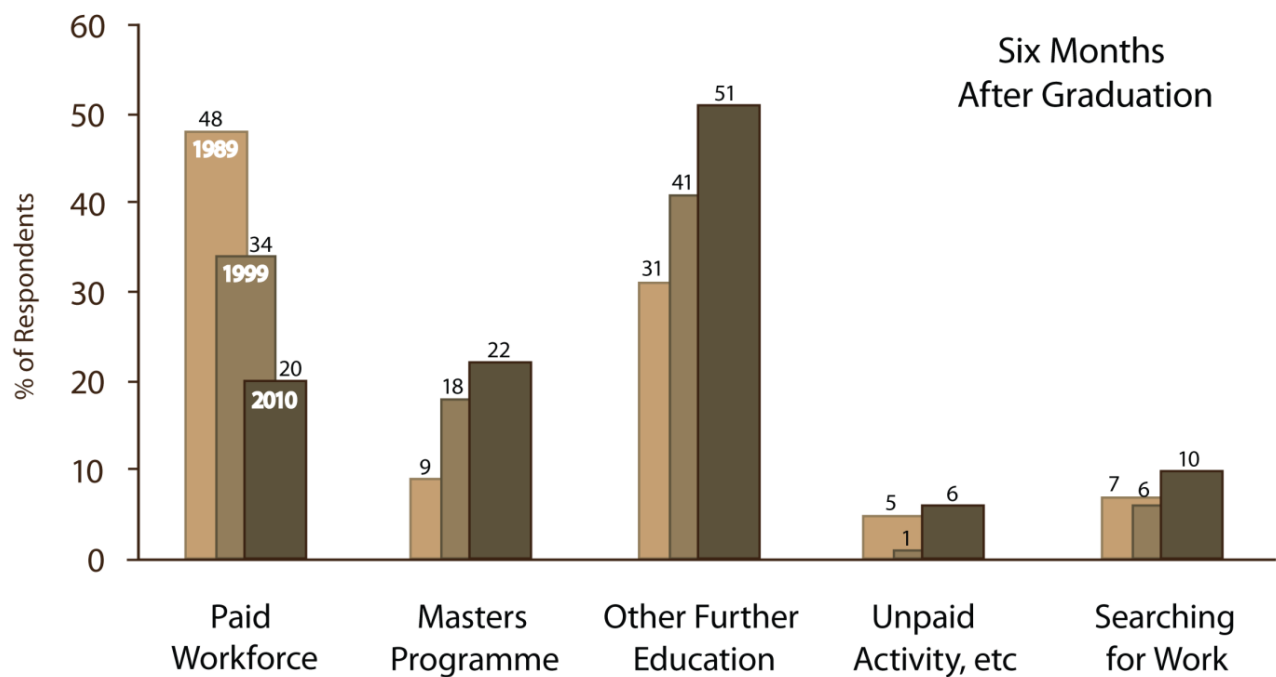


Figure 1. Situation six months after graduation.

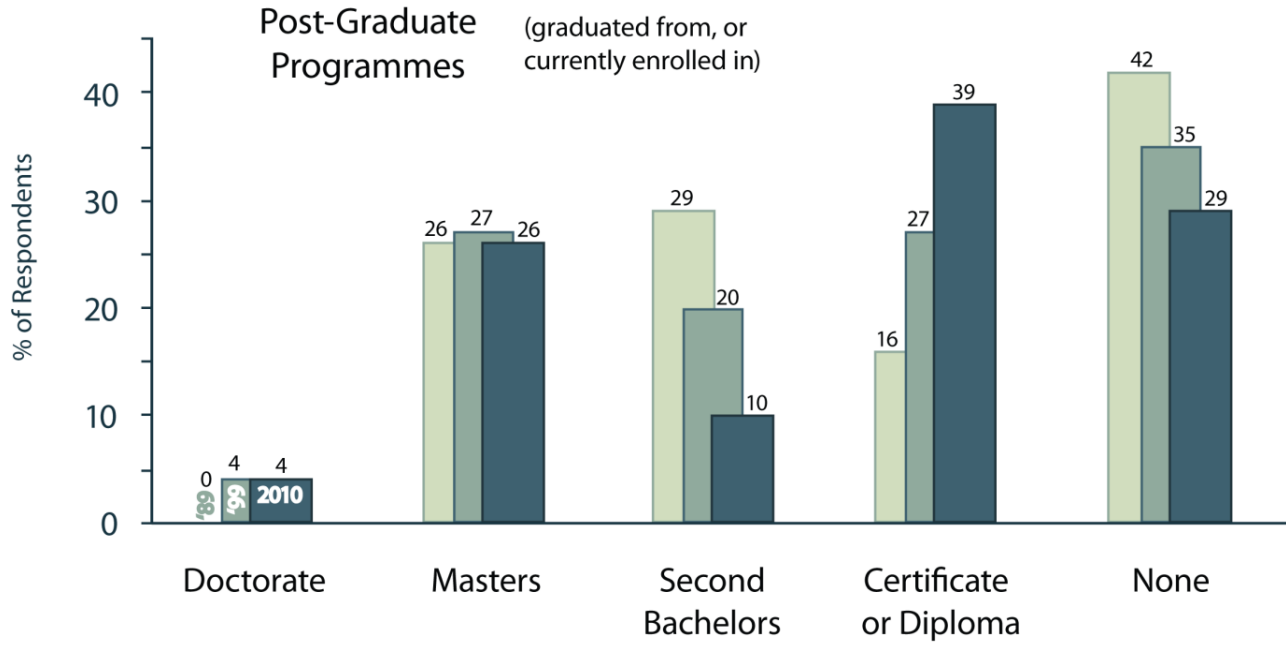


Figure 2. Respondents with post-graduate further education. Some respondents recorded themselves in two categories.

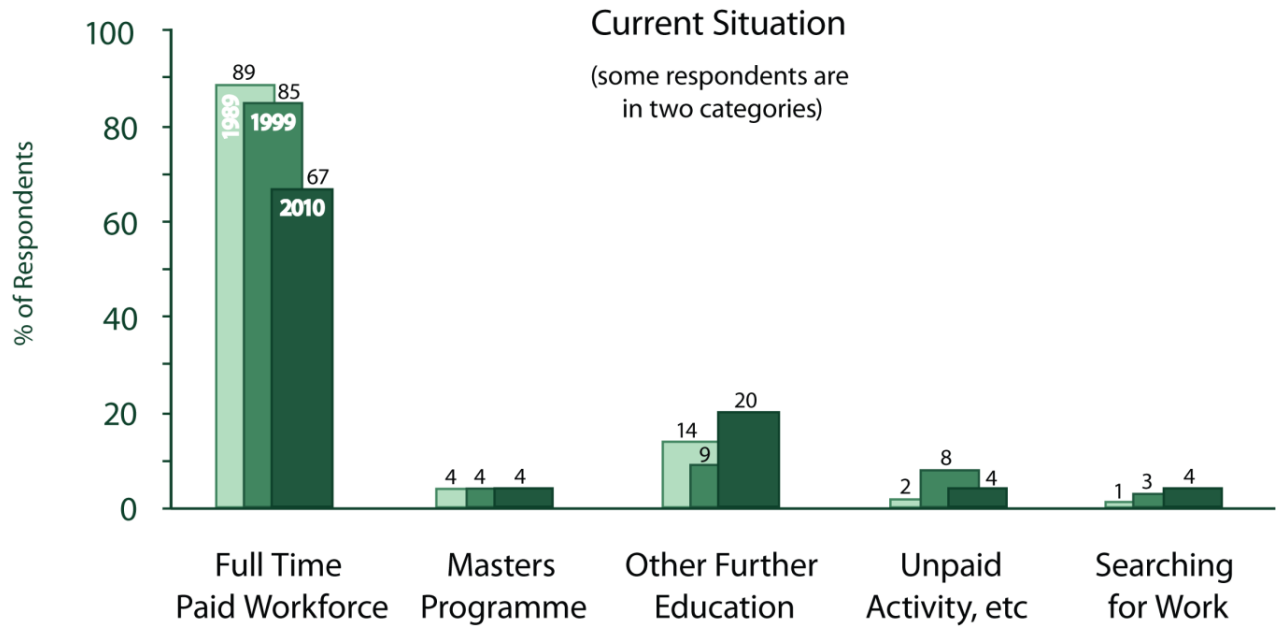


Figure 3. Current Situation. 1989 and 1999 totals do not sum to 100, owing to some double responses. Master's and Further Education may be full- or part-time in these surveys, but full-time only in 2010.

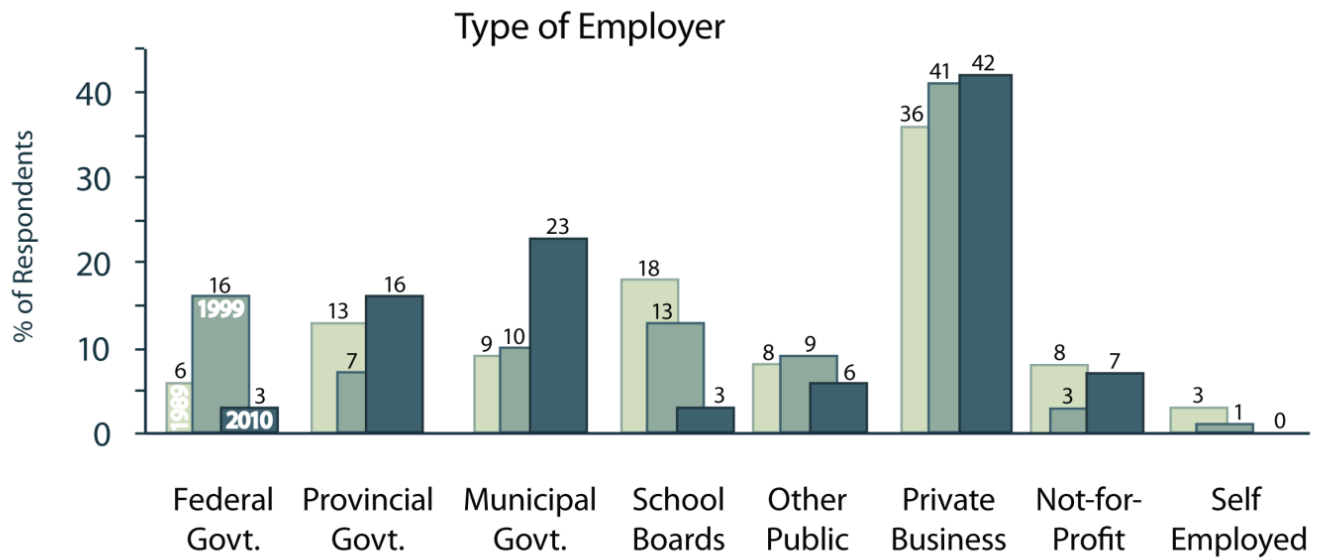


Figure 4. Types of employer, as percent of employed respondents.

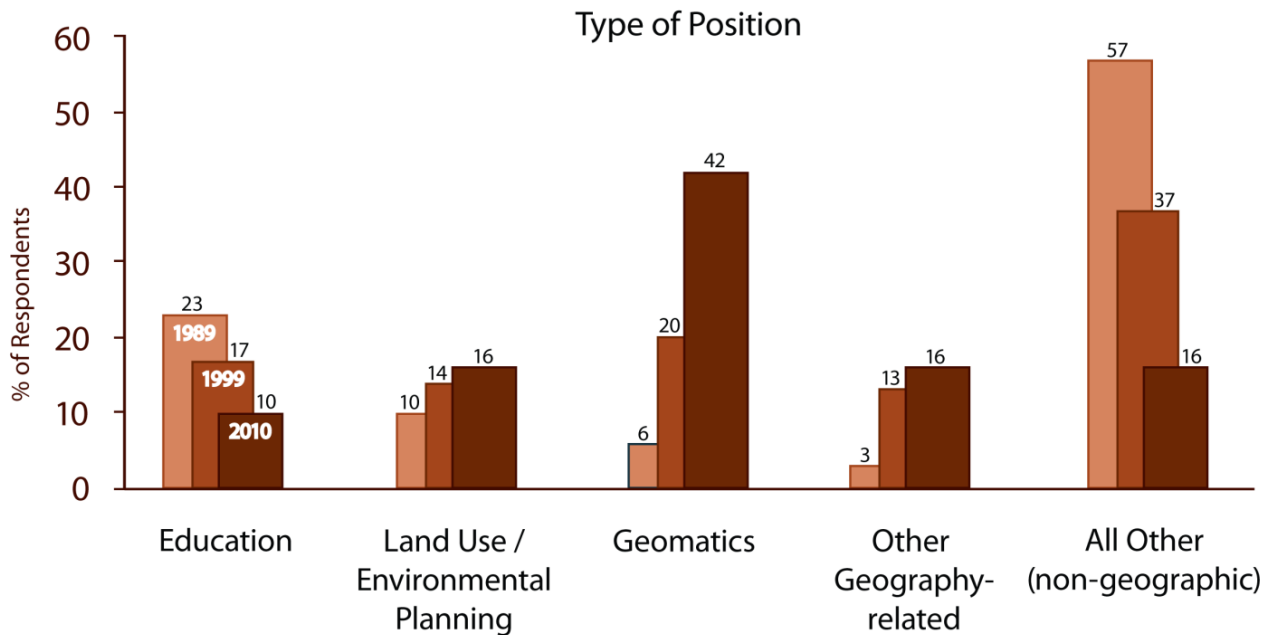


Figure 5. Types of position, as percent of employed respondents.

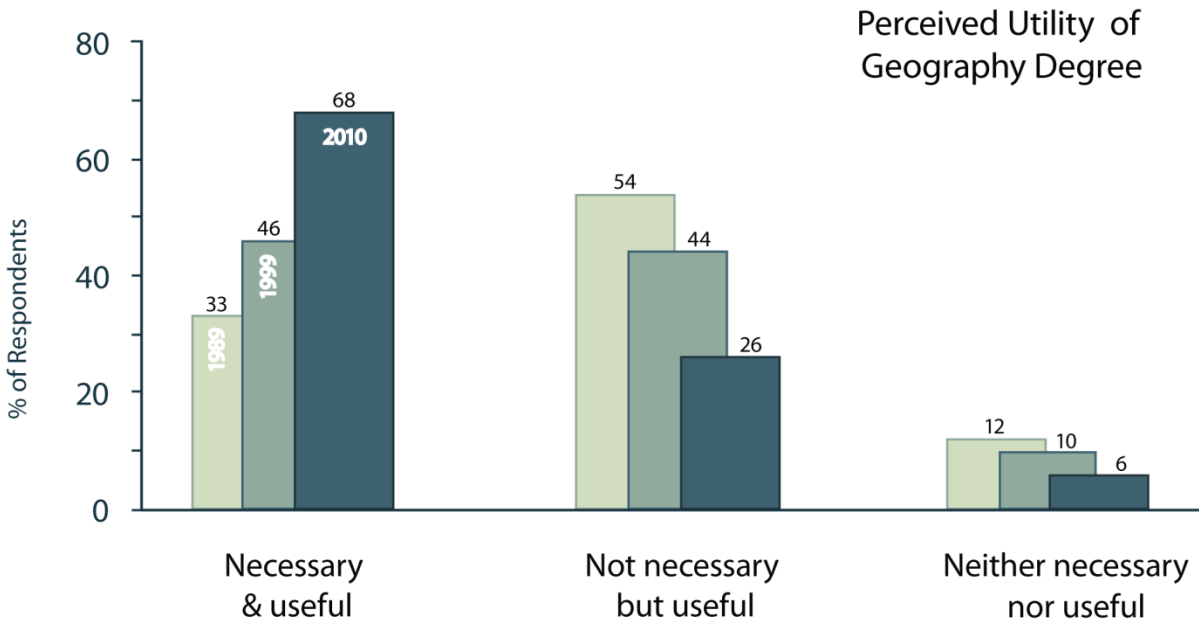


Figure 6. Perceived utility of the geography Bachelor's degree, in relation to present employment.

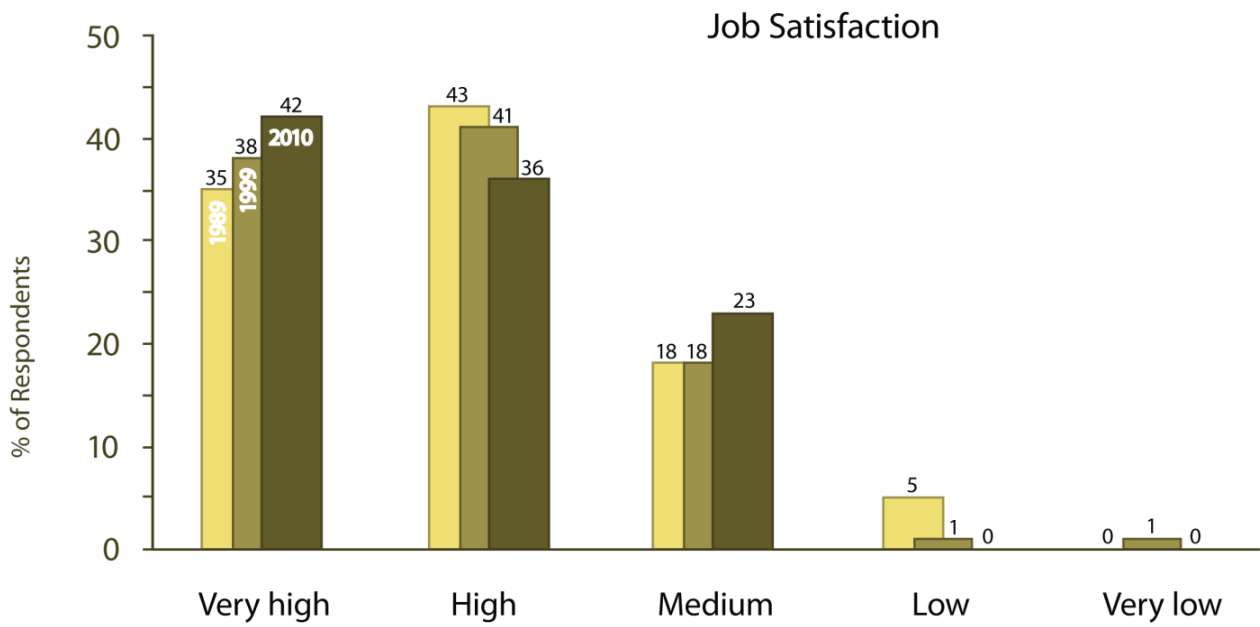


Figure 7. Job satisfaction, for employed respondents.
