Following graduation, he went to New York to pursue a career in writing. He eventually became managing editor, and later the executive editor, of Andy Warhol's Interview Magazine. As well as writing, Robert developed an interest in photography, and was the curator for an exhibition entitled Masters of Photography that travelled throughout the United States, including the National Gallery in Washington, D.C.

Robert was the son of the late Robert Hayes and Lyn Hayes.
