## Management For Change In the Slovak and Czech Republics

<b>Description:</b>	The two projects described here had common goals: the promotion of democracy, national building and Canada / Czech and Canada / Slovak relations through the development of strong and effective management and administrative leadership of the public and private sectors. Project activities included management-training programs for women and men managers from ministries, institutions, and industries, and for instructors of management. In-Canada training included internships and instructor development. Programs for more than 200 Czech and Slovak managers were delivered by Canadian faculty in programs organized by the University of Bratislava and Charles University. An important result of both projects was the networking among Canadian, Czech, and Slovak business persons, as shown in the establishment by alumni of the "Canadian Management Club."
