The Centre provided information on development issues to schools, community groups, and a plethora of institutions in the Atlantic region. As part of the Saint Mary's University campus life, the International Education Centre maintained a development education resource centre that served teachers, students and the general community at all levels. Its extremely active outreach program to schools in the region facilitated the learning of development issues and acted as a resource that supported the development of school curriculum that is in use today. The International Education Centre, as an integral part of Saint Mary's University, also acted as a catalyst bringing international students on campus into closer touch with the local community.</p>
