<b>Description:</b>	This project contributed to the economic reform process in Vietnam, specifically through capacity building at the National Economic University (NEU), a key institution for economic education in that country. Major activities were in-Canada professional upgrading for 26 NEU faculty and in-Hanoi seminars conducted by Canadian partners. This upgrading was supported by training in Gender and Development, English for Academic Purposes (Saint Mary's) and French (Moncton). Results included increased skills and knowledge for NEU faculty and an increased capacity to develop and update curricula related to economic management.
