

## Obtaining Internet Access on Campus

For on campus internet access (in residence, or through the SMUports):

1. Open an internet browser window, this should take you to the Registration Page.
2. If it does not, type "netreg" in the browser address line.

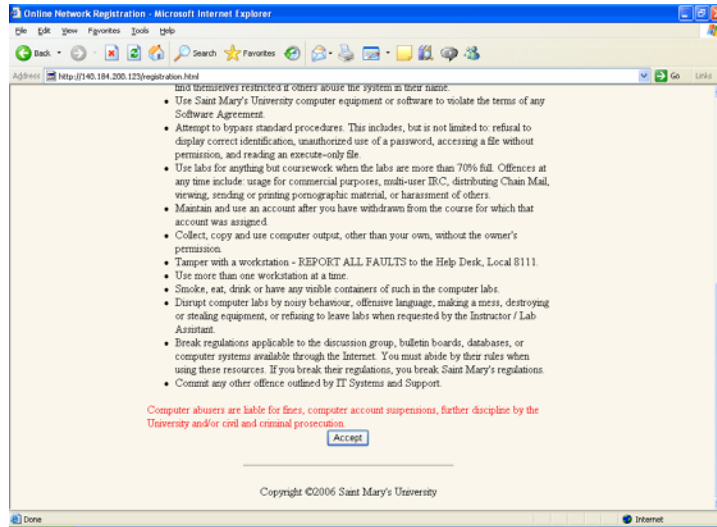


**NOTE: For Wireless access**, you will need to set up your computer with the Wireless Access instructions prior to following these steps. (you can find these instructions online [here](#))

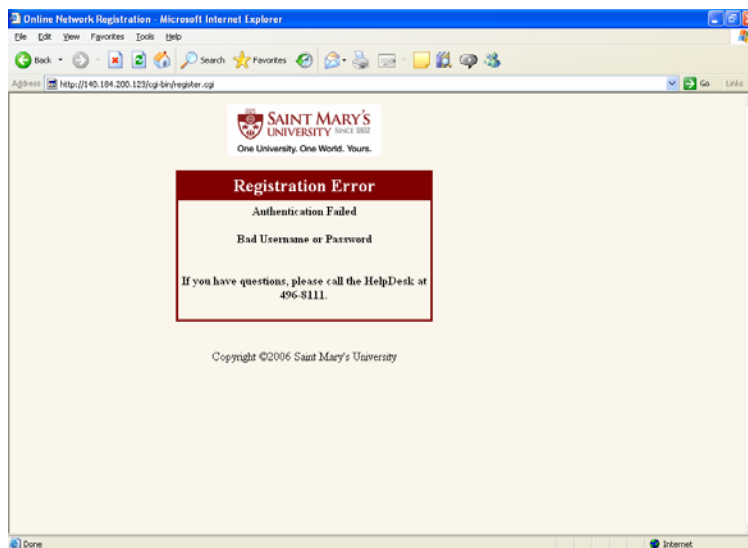
3. Enter your username/password. This is the s# account that you use for the computer labs on campus. If you do not have an account, you will need to visit our ITSS helpdesk for instructions on how to activate your computer account or visit <http://activate.smu.ca>.
4. Once you type in the correct username/password, scroll down to the bottom of the Computer Usage Policy and press the 'Accept' button, as indicated on the following 2 screens.

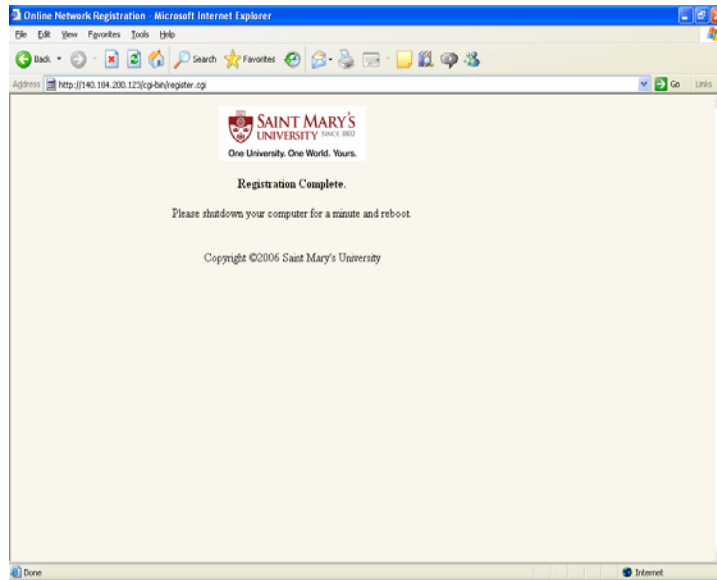

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5. If an incorrect username /password is entered you will see the following screen:

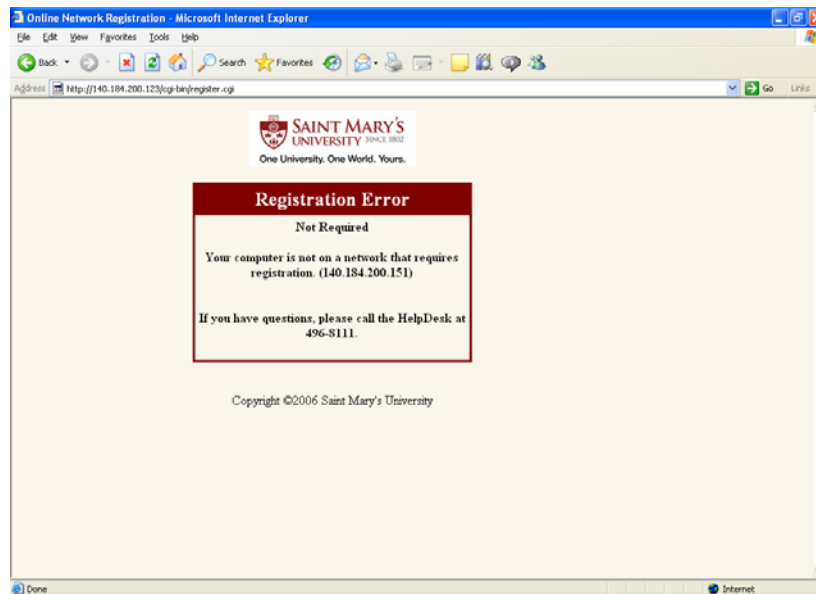


6. After clicking on 'Accept' the following screen should appear, indicating a successful registration:
