Saint Mary's University Men's & Women's Soccer Teams will be hosting the Liverpool Way Soccer School. This internationally renowned camp will also be held in Norway, Denmark and Cyprus this summer.

From 1976–1990 Liverpool Football Club dominated English and European Soccer, winning 10 League Championships, 4 European Cups, the UEFA Cup, 2 FA Cups and 4 League Cup Championships. This period helped make them the most successful English Soccer team in history. Now, some of the stars from those teams will be coming to Saint Mary's University to conduct the Liverpool Way Soccer Schools where your child can learn directly from some of the greats.

Liverpool Football Club was built on teamwork which required each player to be very comfortable with the ball. Campers will be placed in groups based on age and their ability. This camp will focus on all the techniques required for the modern soccer player to be successful. These include dribbling, short and long passing, first touch control, shooting, finishing and goalkeeping. The coaches will work to improve each player while providing a fun learning environment.

David 'Doc' Johnson

Played with Liverpool 1976-1982 also played with Everton and Ipswich

David played striker for Liverpool and scored 78 goals in his six seasons and earned 8 England Caps during this time.

Alan Kennedy

Played with Liverpool 1978-85 and also played with Newcastle and Sunderland.
European Cup Winner: 1981 and 1984
English League Champion: 1979, 1980, 1982, 1983, 1984
English League Cup Winner: 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984
Scored the winning goal in the 1981 European Cup Final vs Real Madrid and scored the winning penalty kick in the 1984 European Cup Final vs Roma.

Bruce Grobbelaar

Played with Liverpool 1981-1994
European Cup Winner: 1984
English League Champion: 1982, 1983, 1984, 1986, 1988, 1990
FA Cup Winner: 1986, 1989, 1992
English League Cup Winner: 1982, 1983, 1984
Bruce was a constant in the Liverpool Goal for over a decade and also played internationally 32 times for Zimbabwe.

David Fairclough

Played with Liverpool from 1974-83
European Cup Winner: 1977, 1978, 1981
UEFA Cup Winner: 1976
English League Champion: 1976, 1977, 1979, 1980, 1982, 1983
English League Cup Winner: 1981,1982,1983
David played striker with Liverpool and scored 55 goals for the club.

Ronnie Whelan

Played with Liverpool from 1979-94
European Cup Winner: 1984
English League Champion: 1982, 1983, 1984, 1986, 1988, 1990
FA Cup Winner: 1986, 1989
English League Cup Winner: 1982, 1983, 1984
Ronnie was midfielder for Liverpool who scored 73 goals for Liverpool. He also played 53 times for the Republic of Ireland including the 1990 and 1994 World Cup and the 1988 European Championships.

Payment Procedures
