



Getting to Saint Mary's University

- Once on Highway 102 South, stay in the right lane. You will come to a fork in the Highway at Exit 5 – stay to the right and continue along the 102 (do not take the exit to Dartmouth).
- Continue along Highway 102 until it ends. It becomes Bayers Road in Halifax. Be careful as you enter the city - the speed limit drops to 70km/hr and then to 50km/hr.
- Just past the Halifax Shopping Centre, turn right on Connaught Avenue.
- Continue along Connaught until you reach the end of the street. There you will turn left on Jubilee Road.
- Continue along Jubilee until you reach Robie Street where you will turn right.
- Take Robie to Inglis Street. Saint Mary's University will be in front of you on the left.

Getting to the Loyola Residence Desk (check in)

- Turn left onto Inglis Street, proceed to the first intersection and turn right on Tower Road.
- Continue along Tower until you reach Gorsebrook Avenue where you will turn right and proceed to Loyola Residence, the 22-storey highrise on the right located at 5865 Gorsebrook Avenue.
- Parking is available for our guests in accommodation in the parking lot located at the corner of Inglis Street and Tower Road (Arena Parking Lot).
A parking pass will be issued upon check-in to residence.
