Applications are invited for a Lecturer Stream position starting July 1, 2012. Faculty who hold appointments in the Lecturer Stream have the primary responsibilities of teaching and service. It is not expected that they engage in research, except to the extent that scholarship enhances their teaching or service activities. Lecturers shall teach four courses per semester during the academic year and two during the summer session. One or more courses may be replaced with other duties with the approval of the Chair and Dean. Among the courses that the Lecturer will be expected to teach, but not limited to these, are Introductory, Research Methods, Statistics, Memory, and Learning.

The successful candidate should have a master's degree in psychology or the equivalent, an established record as a superior teacher and a demonstrated level of satisfactory service at the university level. Candidates should present evidence of their teaching ability and the courses they are interested in teaching. Candidates should also indicate their willingness to supervise undergraduate student research projects.
