

# Saint Mary's University Advanced Placement (AP) Equivalency Chart

Students may receive 6 credit hours of advanced standing for each of the following Advanced Placement (AP) courses, if they achieve grades of 4 or 5.

French	FREN 1111 and FREN 1112
Geography (Human)	GEOG 1901 and GEOG 1902
German Language	GRMN 1101 and GRMN 1102
Government & Politics	POLI 1901 and POLI 1902
History (U.S.)	HIST 1903 and HIST 1904
History (World)	HIST 1905 and HIST 1906
Latin	LATN 1100 (6)
Physics	PHYS 1100 and PHYS 1101
Psychology	PSYC 1200 and PSYC 1240
Spanish	SPAN 1100 (6)
Statistics	MATH 1207 and SCIE 1903

Each of the above courses counts as three credit hours with the exception of LATN 1100 and SPAN 1100 which each count as six credit hours.

Courses are listed in the Saint Mary's University Academic Calendar with the exception of the following electives:

ENGL 1901	unspecified English elective
GEOG 1901, 1902	unspecified Geography electives
HIST 1901, 1902, 1903, 1904, 1905, 1906	unspecified History electives
SCIE 1901, 1902, 1903	unspecified Science electives

Credit for AP examined subjects, not listed above but with a grade of 4 or 5, will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Note: Credit is not awarded on the basis of interim school, predicted or mock results. In addition, students have the choice of refusing credits.
