****Nova Scotia residents who are full time will receive the "Nova Scotia University Student Bursary" which reduces tuition fees up to \$ 1283.00. Part time students receive a pro-rated amount. Canadian students who do not receive the NS University Student Bursary received a bursary up to \$261.00. The bursary is not available to the Master of Finance, Executive MBA or MBA-CMA programs.**

¹Annual tuition for part-time students is one-half of the full-time amount. The length of part-time programs is double the full-time length.

²MBA -CMA program has a separate fee/payment schedule. Full Program Fee = \$11,340 payable; 50% Aug 31-1st year, 40% Aug 31 2nd year and 10% April 30 3rd yr. Differential fees are charged at a rate of \$575.00 per course.

³Full-time fee includes SMUSA Fee, U-Pass Metro Bus Pass, Journal Newspaper. Part-time fee of \$48.00 includes SMUSA Fee and Journal.

⁴Fee is based on single coverage: Family plan Medical & Dental is \$429 for domestic students and
\$1,962 (International student with 1 dependant) \$2728.50 (International student with more than 1 dependant)

⁵Thesis binding fee is included in program tuition.

⁶Definition of Nova Scotia Resident:

Two Criteria were used to identify Nova Scotia residents and eligibility for the NS University Student Bursary:

- a. Nova Scotia residents are defined as those students in receipt of a Nova Scotia student loan
- b. For students without a student loan, Nova Scotia residency is determined using the following guidelines:
 - Students entering university immediately after Nova Scotia high school completion (i.e. within the last twelve (12) months,
 - for all other Canadian students (i.e. not coming immediately after Nova Scotia high school completion), the province of permanent home address on the date of application for admission must be Nova Scotia
