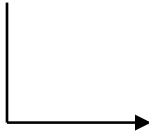

(a) All NEW undergraduate students not in Category B

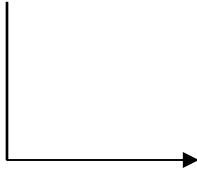
