2 FULL-TIME, SESSIONAL APPOINTMENTS**

The Department of Mathematics and Computing Science at Saint Mary's University invites applications for 2 full-time, eight-month sessional positions in Computing Science at the rank of Assistant Professor, to begin Sept. 1, 2018. Candidates should have a Ph.D. in Computer Science; and must both have a strong commitment to teaching and demonstrate an ability to pursue innovative research. The successful candidate will be expected to teach a total of five courses over two academic semesters at undergraduate and graduate levels as well as maintain an active research program. In particular, an ability to teach Data Analytics (Databases, Business Intelligence, Data Mining), Web/Mobile/Cloud app development, Data Communications and Networks, Artificial Intelligence, or Operating Systems will be an asset.

The Faculty of Science, which houses the Department of Mathematics and Computing Science, has gone through significant renewal in the past decade, with many new and active faculty involved in teaching and research. Our facilities have also been renewed and all space housing members of the Faculty of Science and the Department of Mathematics and Computing Science have been renovated and upgraded within the last five years. We are working to establish and build upon areas of distinct research strength and through those foster collaborations locally, regionally, and internationally.

Saint Mary's University is located in the historic port city of Halifax, Nova Scotia, a vibrant, urban community of over 350,000 people. Halifax is a major educational centre for Atlantic Canada and is home to five universities.
