Nelson is a city located in the Selkirk Mountains on the extreme West Arm of Kootenay Lake in the Southern Interior of British Columbia, Canada (Wikipedia). The hotels and the meeting space are a short walk from each other.

Transport

The closest airport is West Kootenay Regional Airport (Castlegar, British Columbia). Code: YCG. There is only one airline that flies into this airport – [Air Canada](#). Air Canada connects to the YCG airport from Vancouver (YVR) or Calgary (YYC). Keep in mind there are only 3 flights per day from the other airports so plan your flights in advance. Queen City Shuttle runs transport (about a 30 min drive) from YCG airport to Nelson. Arrangements can be made online [here](#). The cost each way is about \$30 CAD. Some may choose to fly into Spokane, Washington (USA) and drive to Nelson – a 3 hour drive by rental car or via [Queen City Shuttle](#) (about \$130 CAD per person each way).

If you choose to drive from one of the nearest major cities, Nelson is roughly an 8 hour drive from Vancouver or Calgary.

Once in Nelson, nearly all hotels and restaurants are within walking distance from each other (this is a very small city). If you require a taxi cab, Glacier Cab Company can be reached at 1-250-354-1111.
