VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

1. Volunteer Tutor/Mentor: Volunteer tutors make our academic support component possible by tutoring individual and groups of students (Grades 9-12) in a supportive environment. Our tutors/mentors assist in building resiliency in youth by helping youth focus, problem solve, and build academic skills that they can apply to all learning situations while also acting as a positive adult role model in their lives. . Students are provided opportunities to connect with role models, mentors, future employers, and post-secondary Institutions through the leadership (mentoring) component of the program. We are looking for volunteer tutors/mentors who are able to volunteer 1-2 hours per week. Our academic support sessions run Monday-Thursday at 3:30-4:30pm and 4:45-5:45pm.

2.
