

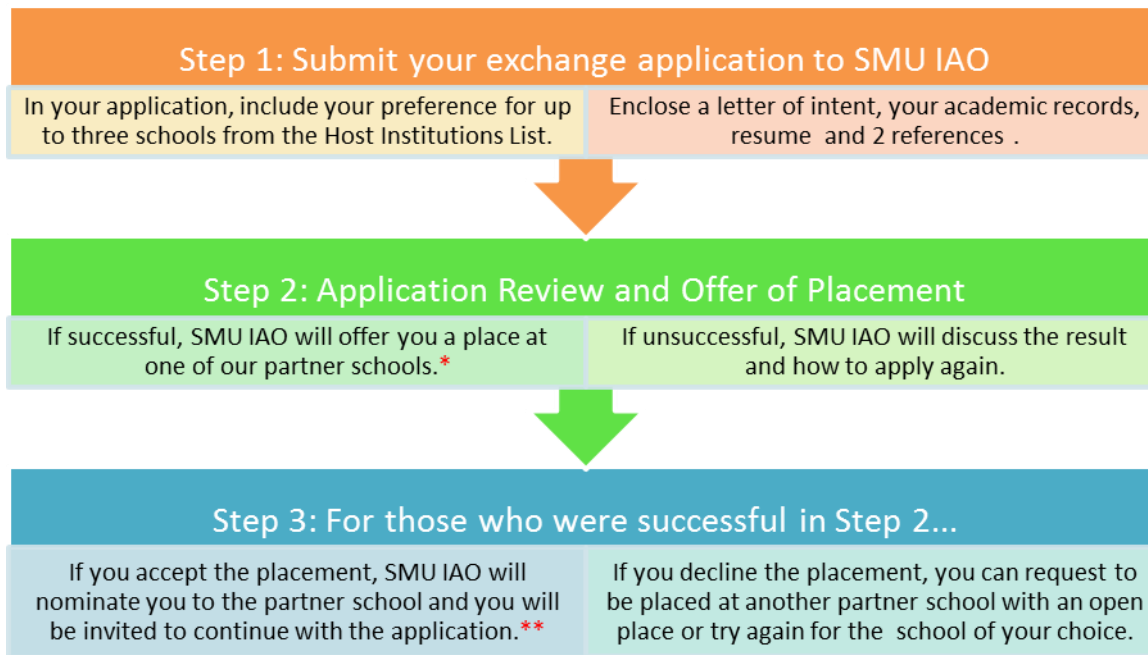
# Saint Mary's University Exchange Program – Host Institutions List

### Information about the Host Institutions List (please read before you review the list)

For all studies which take place at Saint Mary's partner universities, you will have to first go through the [application process](#) organized by the **SMU International Activities Office (SMU IAO)**. Here are the application steps in brief:



\*During the placement process for successful applications, your preference will be taken into consideration as much as possible, but you may or may not be chosen for the school of your initial choices. Typically, there are one to two exchange places available for each partner school, and some places can be popular and competitive. \*\*The final decision on admission is made by the host university.

The **application deadlines** for the fall/winter semester exchange and a full-year exchange programs to take place in the following academic year are **January 10** (study in Japan) and **February 10** (study elsewhere). Summer abroad applications in most cases are due on various dates in **February**. Late applications are accepted while places are available.

### How to select a host university:

When you review the list, consider the location, subjects offered and the program level, language of instruction and program dates. For the subject areas on the list, the checkmarks are for your guide only and you should broaden your scope as to your study possibilities. For example, BComm and BSc students looking to fulfill free electives should check out programs that offer Arts courses. As well, some commerce-oriented schools may offer basic-level business courses that don't require pre-requisites so those schools are open to non-Commerce students. Once you pick out a selection of host universities, visit their website for more information on courses, housing, monthly living expenses, student visa, and any other relevant information.
