

Study Room Policy

Study rooms are for the use of Saint Mary's students, to be used for group study.

- There must be a minimum of two students registered and present in the room. If there are fewer than two, students may be asked by Library staff to give the room to a waiting group.

These rooms cannot be reserved for paid tutorials.

Reservations are limited to two hours per day, per group.

The maximum capacity for each study room is:

- Eight people for study rooms 1-9
- Fifteen people for study room 10

The condition of the room is the responsibility of those who booked the room.

- If there is a concern about the condition of a room, please inform the Circulation Desk immediately. Do not wait until the end of the booking. Current users of the room may be held responsible for any damage.

Study Rooms are not sound proof.

- Please respect the needs of fellow Library users by keeping the noise level to a minimum
- Please keep conversation to a minimum when traveling to and from the study room

Do not leave valuables in study rooms.

The University's Code of Student Conduct and the Library's Noise Policy are applicable in all study rooms.
