The position is open to any field, however there is a preference for Development, Applied Microeconomics, Mathematical Economics and Econometrics. Candidates with a demonstrated record in research and teaching in these fields are especially encouraged to apply. The successful candidate will have completed, or be near completion of, a PhD in economics, and have excellent qualifications for research and teaching in our graduate and undergraduate programs. The appointment will commence July 1, 2017 or when the position is filled.
