The Minor in English Language allows students to study the English language as a subject, explicitly focusing on its grammar, its history and varieties, its uses and users. In taking the minor, students will not only acquire extensive knowledge of English, but also learn how to describe a particular language and its varieties, and how to linguistically characterize instances of discourse in English — from everyday talk and texts to literary genres.

Prerequisite: Three (3) credit hours in ENGL at the 1000 level
