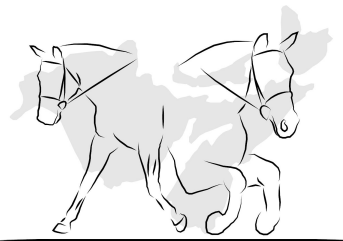

*You must qualify for at least one of the following:*

- Winning three (3) first place ribbons in an equitation over fences or medal class at a height of 2'9 (~0.85m) or higher in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit.
- Winning three (3) first place ribbons in Intermediate O/F the previous year
- Placing four (4) times in an equitation over fences, medal class, hunter over fences, or jumper class at a height of 3'0" (~0.90m) or higher in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit.
- An Eventing qualifying score at the Training Level or above.
- Showing Second Level in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit. Only makes you eligible for under saddle (U/S). An appeal must be submitted.
- Having competed in the Open Division on the AIEL circuit the previous year.
- Show as a professional on the Equine Canada Circuit.
- Equine Canada Learn to Ride Level 8 certification.
- Canadian Pony Club Level C.
- Champion of the 2019-2020 Intermediate O/F class

### **Intermediate Division**

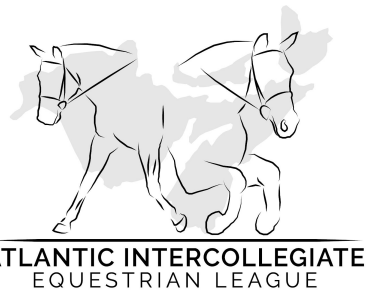
*You must qualify for at least one of the following:*

- Winning three (3) first place ribbons in an equitation over fences or medal class at a height of 2'6" (~0.75m) or higher in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit.
- Winning three (3) first place ribbons in Novice O/F the previous year
- Placing four (4) times in an equitation over fences, medal class, hunter over fences, or jumper class at a height at 2'9" (~0.85) or higher in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit.
- An Eventing qualifying score at the Pre-Training Level.
- Showing First Level in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit. Only makes you eligible for under saddle (U/S). An appeal must be made.
- Having competed in the Intermediate Division on the AIEL circuit the previous year.
- Equine Canada Learn to Ride Level 7 certification.
- Canadian Pony Club Level D2.
- Champion of the 2019-2020 Novice O/F class

### **Novice Division**

*You must qualify for at least one of the following:*

- Winning three (3) first place ribbons in an equitation over fences or medal class at a height of 2'3" (~0.70m) or higher in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit.
- Winning three (3) first place ribbons in Entry O/F the previous year
- Placing four (4) times in an equitation over fences, medal class, hunter over fences, or jumper class at a height of 2'6 (~0.75m) or higher in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit.
- An Eventing qualifying score at the Entry Level or above



- Showing Training Level in a show that is part of a series or recognized circuit. Only makes you eligible for under saddle (U/S). An appeal must be made.
- Having competed in the Novice Division on the AIEL circuit the previous year.
- Equine Canada Learn to Ride Level 6 certification.
- Champion of the 2019-2020 Entry O/F class

### **Entry Division**

*You must qualify for at least one of the following:*

- Being part of a hunter, jumper, equitation, or eventing lesson program at a level which ensures the individual is jumping consistently at a height of 2'0 (0.6) or higher for the past four months, at minimum. This must be able to be confirmed by your instructor.
- Equine Canada Learn to Ride Level 4 certification.
- Canadian Pony Club Level D1.
- Having competed in the Entry Division on the AIEL circuit the previous year.
