Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. WHERE DO I CHECK-IN?

Our check-in desk is located at the 5865 Gorsebrook Ave. (off Tower Rd.) main floor Loyola Residence (across from the Art Gallery). We recommend you stop at the round-about (located at the very end of Gorsebrook Avenue) and check-in prior to parking or unloading luggage.

2. IS PARKING FREE?

YES, we are pleased to provide you with free parking when staying with us in our overnight accommodations. Simply request a parking pass at the time of check-in.

3. DO YOU HAVE FREE WIFI?

YES, we do have free WIFI. At time of check-in simply request an access code.

4. IS THERE ACCESS TO A GYM?

YES, the Homburg Fitness Centre is available to overnight guests. (Must be 16 years of age or older.)

5. WHAT TIME IS BREAKFAST?

Our hot breakfast is available 7 days-a-week, 7:30 - 9:00AM and is included in your nightly room rate.

6. WHAT ARE SOME POPULAR HALIFAX ATTRACTIONS?

Halifax Citadel National Historic Site, the Canadian Museum of Immigration at Pier 21, Casino Nova Scotia, the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, the award-winning new Halifax Public Library, and the new Discovery Centre. (Please see our Welcome Book in your room for more detail.)

7. DOES SAINT MARY'S UNIVERSITY HAVE LAUNDRY FACILITIES?

8. DO YOU SUPPLY ALARM CLOCKS, IRONS OR HAIR DRYERS?

YES, based on availability. (These items may be signed out at our Loyola Check-In Desk.)

9. DO YOU HAVE AIR CONDITIONING?

While we do have fans in each room, we do not have air conditioning.

10. HOW ARE THE TAXES BROKEN DOWN AND APPLIED?

We are required by law to charge a standard 15% HST (Federal Harmonized Sales Tax) and a 2% city/marketing tax on each nightly room rate. Please note that Booking.com and Expedia show our rates prior to these applicable taxes.

11. IS THERE ANY TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE TO AND FROM THE HALIFAX INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT?
