Program Highlights

Orientation

In August before classes begin, Master's and Graduate Diploma students take part in a 5day face-to-face orientation at Saint Mary's University to kick start the program and build relationships with students and faculty.

Co-operative Study Tour

The Field Research course is an integral part of the Master's program and includes an international <u>co-operative study tour</u>. This is an opportunity for hands-on learning focused on exemplary models of co-operation. Get exposure to co-operative innovations, network with leaders, interrogate problems and witness solutions. Students embark on a 10-day tour to Mondragón, Spain or Emilia-Romagna, Italy.

Independent Research Project

For the Master's program, this <u>final research</u> <u>project</u> course gives students the chance to apply their learning to their co-operative or credit union or to the co-operative sector more broadly. Students design a project that interests them and leverages the knowledge they have gained throughout the program. They are matched with a faculty member or expert from our community as a supervisor to support the process.

Faculty

Students can expect to dive into critical issues affecting the co-operative economy with the support and guidance from committed and <u>quality researchers and practitioners</u>, many with direct ties to the co-operative sector. The online nature of our programs enables us to work with experts internationally.

- Masters: \$35,000 CAD
- Diploma: \$16,000 CAD

Programs Tailored to You

Study and Grow Your Career

- Masters: 3 years | 42 credit hours
- <u>Diploma</u>: 16 months | 21 credit hours
- <u>Certificate</u>: 10 months | 5 courses noncredit professional development with advanced standing if going on to Masters or Graduate Diploma

Programs are structured to allow students to work while studying. Anticipate a workload of 15-20h/week or 8-10h/week for the Certificate Program (mostly asynchronous).

Building Blocks

Our programs are designed as building blocks so students can expand their learning journey to their needs and liking. Certificate students can go on to the larger programs and be given advanced standing in those five courses. It is also easy to switch between the Graduate Diploma and Master's program.

Certificate Program

The <u>Certificate in Co-operative Management</u> is a non-credit professional development program (online, part-time) for co-operative practitioners who want to expand their knowledge of co-operative and credit union management tools and best practices. The program includes five courses related to the history of the movement, the enterprise model, strategic advantage, governance and innovation. The program cost is \$7,000 CAD (subject to change).
