## VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES

### School Program Instructor:

Work with elementary students in an educational setting and discover the wonders of natural and cultural history. Volunteers are required to commit to one set morning a week for a three hour shift, for a period of three months in the Fall and/or Spring terms. Volunteers who facilitate our education programs must be 18 years of age and enjoy working with elementary-age students in a lively environment.

### Public Program Assistant:

Be a friendly face in the exhibits and assist visitors with questions. Volunteers will also guide visitors through hands-on Museum programs. Public Program Assistants commit to a three hour shift during a 3 – 6 month term. Public Program Assistants have shifts on the weekends throughout the year, and can volunteer on a weekday during the summer months.
