How to Book Appointments



1. Booking by phone:

Depending on the availability of staff, return calls can take 4-6 hours.

2. Pomelo health

Pomelo health is an online patient portal that allows you to:

- Book/cancel/reschedule appointments
- Communicate with clinic staff
- Receive medical records/files directly
- Receive text message/email appointment reminders

Pomelo health is the preferred method of booking and will save you time.

To register for Pomelo, follow the steps below:

- Complete the SMU Clinic Registration
 Form, found on our website under
 the "book an appointment tab". The
 completed form is received by
 reception staff. Upon review, they create
 your medical chart and will send you a
 confirmation email.
- 2. Check your email for a Pomelo Health link and access passcode.
- 3. Login to Pomelo and set your account preferences.
- 4. Book your appointments with Pomelo.
