To be considered for admission, you'll need a minimum overall 70% average, with no individual course below 60%, in the five senior-level academic courses required for your program (below). Visit smu.ca/admissions for requirements by curriculum or for non-high school applicants, and for a list of approved courses. *Please note: Only approved courses will be used to calculate admissions averages. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure they have the required approved courses.*

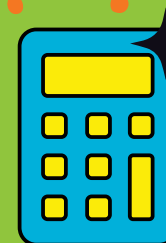
